## TASK DESCRIPTION

You are part of a team that needs to develop a shared, deep understanding of literature through the shared context of the poetry of Seamus Heaney.

As a whole-class team, you need to develop a range of resources that can be shared and used online to be part of each other's study regimen.

Each of you will need to develop a unique component of that. The product you will produce will be a presentation of no more than 5 mins that you will deliver to the class, support by appropriate visual stimulus. Your presentation will be recorded as a screencast and posted online.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Preparation

- 1. As a team, brainstorm the range off understandings that are important to developing a deep understanding of the poetry.
- 2. Break these down into chunks. Keep in mind the permutations that are available. For instance, while a syllabus concept might be a focus, two students might examine this in the context of different poems.
- 3. As a class, you will develop your own success criteria. These will need to be able to account for various degrees of achievement.

#### **Presentation**

- You will present your product as an oral presentation supported by visuals (e.g. PowerPoint, Prezi). You may use Keynote, but you will need to prearrange this with the teacher so that a Mac can be made available.
- The screen of your presentation and your oral will be recorded and the product will be placed on The Mazenod College YouTube Channel (see permission below).
